Respected Madam,

It is always my privilege to write to you, but this time with a heavy heart I am forced to bring an unfortunate incident of autocracy on four Poor Tribal Women namely Martina Kisku, Shiuli Mardi, Thakran Soren and Malati Murmu residing within my constituency.

On 06<sup>th</sup> of April about 200 people belonging to the Tribal families under Tapan Assembly constituency of my Balurghat Lok Sabha area joined BJP. This does not went well with a section of Trinamool Leadership and those families were put into severe pressure by Goons of Trinamool Congress and some of them were forced to join TMC. Had it been done democratically, we have nothing to say, but inhuman medieval period autocracy was met out by forcing them "Dandavat Parikrama" for about 1 km as punishment before handing over the TMC Flag in the Trinamool District Party Office.
